

Environmental Management Policy

1. Purpose

LS EV KOREA considers the environment as a core management element throughout the entire product development, design, production, service, and disposal process. We establish and implement an environmental management policy to improve environmental performance through compliance with laws and regulations and continuous improvement.

2. Scope

This policy applies to LS EV KOREA's business sites, processes, facilities, products/services, logistics, and auxiliary activities, as well as the employees and partners engaged in these activities.

3. Basic Principles

1) Fulfillment of Laws and Compliance Obligations

We strictly comply with environmental laws and regulations, permit and licensing requirements, and the demands of stakeholders such as customers and local communities.

2) Environmental Aspect Management and Pollution/Accident Prevention

We systematically identify and evaluate environmental aspects and prevent pollution and accidents related to air, water, waste, and chemicals.

3) Improved Energy and Resource Efficiency and Emission Reduction

We improve the efficiency of electricity, water, and raw materials, and systematically manage and reduce greenhouse gases and emissions.

4) Waste Minimization and Proper Disposal Management

We reduce waste generation, expand reuse and recycling, and mitigate environmental impact through proper disposal and traceability.

5) Chemical Safety Management throughout the Life Cycle

We minimize hazardous substance risks throughout the entire process, from purchasing and storage to use, transportation, and disposal, and prepare for emergencies.

6) Environmental Impact Reduction through Technology and Process Improvement

We proactively eliminate and reduce environmental pollution and risk factors through technological improvements and innovations in products, processes, and facilities.

7) Environmental Goals, Continuous Improvement, and Expanded Stakeholder Participation

We establish and evaluate environmental goals, continuously improve our management system, and strengthen employee training and communication with external stakeholders.
